Miami health firm sells small hospital

Pacer Health, a small Miami company, announced it had sold Minnie G. Boswell Memorial Hospital in Greene County, Ga., to Saint Joseph's Health System of Atlanta.

Terms of the deal were not announced.

The hospital has 25 beds. Pacer Health has managed it since 2004, when it agreed to purchase the hospital when it was less than a month from closing down.

Pacer is a bulletin board stock trading as PHLH. On Monday, it was trading around half-a-cent a share.
