Pacer Health Signs Agreement for New Hospital Information System

Purchase to add over \$5 million in software and equipment to Pacer's facilities

HCS, which is based in New Jersey, was founded in 1969 to provide healthcare organizations with a fully integrated, comprehensive system of clinical and financial applications. HCS will be installing INTERACTANT at Pacer’s facilities, which is comprised of modular, on-line, real-time applications.

Alert Life Sciences, provides an all-inclusive suite of clinical software to hospitals. The software is designed to meet the needs of nurses and physicians using a completely paperless, touch-screen system and electronic medical records.

Alert and HCS will interface to provide a comprehensive state-of-the-art clinical and financial information system, making Pacer Health and its facilities completely paperless.

Pacer’s executives expect implementation to be completed within the next twelve months.
